


Discerning the Body of Christ

• A. The Church is the body of Christ (Eph 1:22-23, Col 1:24), local churches specifically: (Romans 12, Eph 4, 1 Co 12).



The Church is the Body of Christ

- Eph 1:22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church,
- Eph 1:23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

• Col 1:24 Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church:

• The church is a <u>Purchased</u> <u>Possession</u>: (Acts 20:28, Eph 1:14).



The Church is a Purchased Possession

• Act 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.





• The body of Christ is <u>our</u> identity.




Ye are.....

A. Note the singular Noun:


B. One body: This is why the Bible and MBT focused on <u>unity</u>. Not 2 or a hundred bodies!

A. Each member <u>matters</u>! (1 Co 12)






The Pharisee did not take care of the Body of Christ:


- Wash Feet

- Anoint








