love – cross your heart with your arms

sound - hit your flat palm with your fist

mind – touch your temple with your index finger

2nd – sign for the number two – hold two fingers up

Timothy – sign for letter “T” – thumb in between index in middle finger

1 – sign for the number one – hold up index finger

7 – sign for the number seven – touch thumb to ring finger with all other fingers extended
