

I. Choosing a song to put a verse to:

1. Is there a song that has the same theme? Maybe it starts with the same words?

Phil. 4:6 – Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

I put this verse to the children's song – "O Be Careful Little Hands".
It has both the theme and starts with the same words.

2. If it's a short verse: pick a short song, maybe a children's song, or the chorus of a song.

Prov. 2:17 - Which forsaketh the guide of her youth, and forgetteth the covenant of her God.

I put this verse to the short song - "Thy Word Have I Hid In Mine Heart".

3. If your verse is long: you'll want to put it to a long song.

2Co 10:5-6 - Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

V6 - And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your obedience is fulfilled.

I put this verse to the song – "Holiness". I put verse 5 to the chorus and verse 6 to the verse.

4. You could put verses to themes from movies.

2Th 3:1 - Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:

I put this verse to the theme from Harry Potter.

5. You can put verses to Christmas songs.

1Ti 5:14 - I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully.

II. How to put the verse to the song:

1. Write down the verse in phrases to match the song.

2. Underline the downbeats, the first beat of each phrase.

3. Put in hyphens for any extra syllables.

Activity:
