



**Review: DBM:** As we lead our community Bible studies in fulfillment of the great commission, we need to be like waiters at the table of Prov. 9. The table is set with the Word of God. The lighting is of the Holy Ghost. The fellowship is with other believers. (Prov 9:1-6, 1 Co 2:13, Heb 4:12).

**Creation to Christ (C2C):** Contextualizing the \_\_\_\_\_. (C2C) is a Biblical, simple, and effective Bible study method that we will use in LWC studies.

**1. It is Biblical:**

A. Romans 1:15-17: Paul declares his \_\_\_\_\_ to preach the gospel to them at Rome and states the gospel is the power of God unto salvation. However, instead of preaching the gospel, he spends 11 chapters \_\_\_\_\_ it.
