



Review: Creation to Christ (C2C): Contextualizing the gospel. (C2C) is a Biblical, simple, and effective Bible study method that we will use in LWC studies.

1. C2C: a set of stories or passages (“Story set”) which leads the Bible study members from the creation to Christ. DBM, not “SOT” is the method of teaching these passages. Some plans are longer than others.

A. You have know the Bible better to do DBM than you do “S.O.T.” (traditional) Bible study.

- Because you have to answer questions about what others do not know, not simply present what you do know.
- C2C helps us see and present the big picture of God’s plan and our place in it. It is more about his plan than it is our salvation. (Gen 1:1, Rev 22:17. Eph 1:14-23, 2:19-22, 3:1-21).

B. You have to be more in tune with others to do DBM than you do S.O.T. (1 Co 9:19-23)

C. You have to be more in tune with the Holy Ghost with DBM than you do with S.O.T. (1 Co 2:4, Luke 12:12).

2. Exactly which story set we follow is not the most important thing. Prayer, and consistent DBM/C2C are the important things. Know “where you are”: Know what you have covered, where you are, and where you are going in the lessons.
