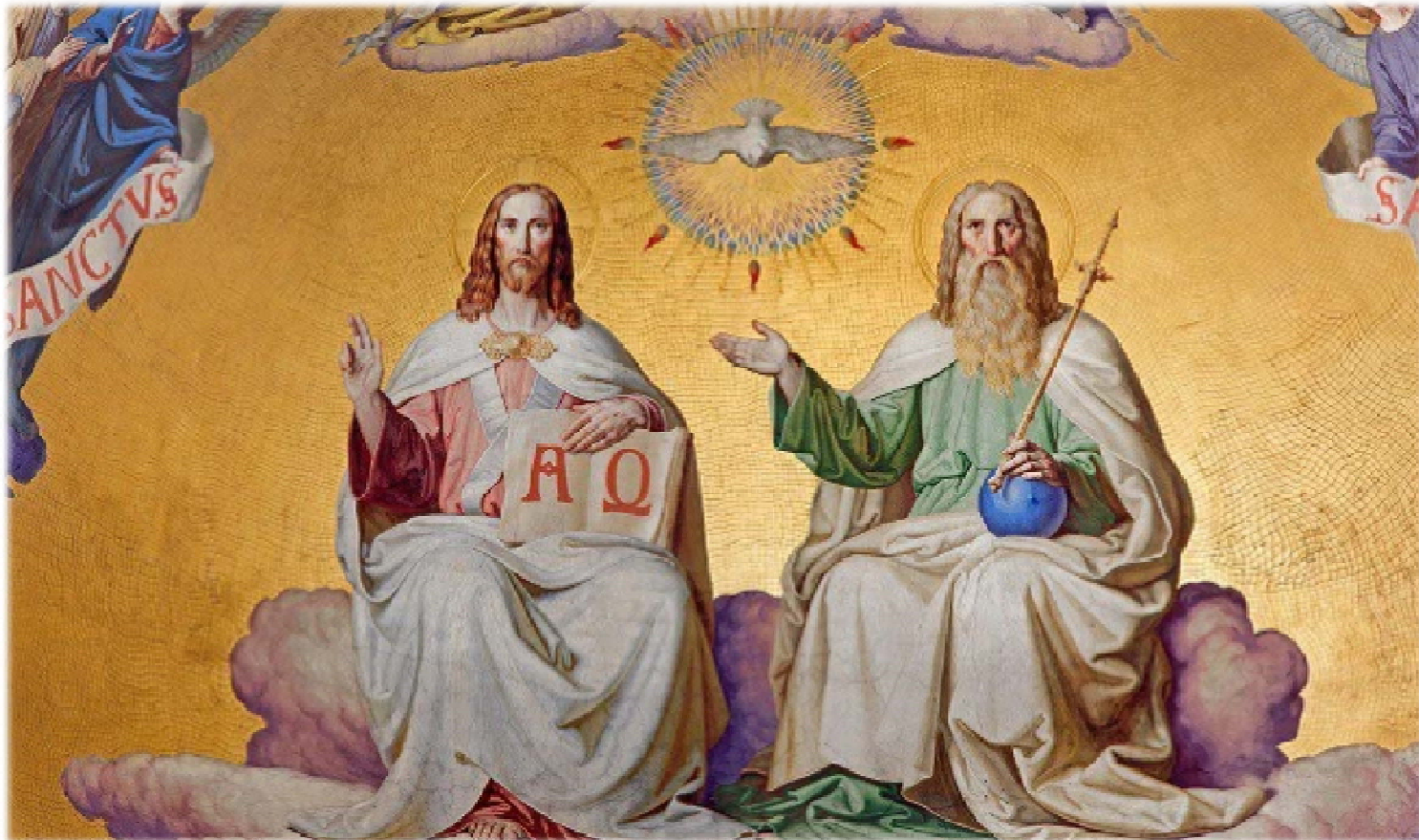


Where is John?

Transitional book from the Jews to Gentiles	Acts	A historical account of the acts of the apostles following the ascension of Christ.
Books written to the churches	Romans 1Corinthians 2Corinthians Galatians Ephesians Philippians Colossians 1Thessalonians 2Thessalonians	Doctrinal section of the Church Age. Romans is the best for doctrines. Doctrines immediately proceed transition.
Books written to individuals	1Timothy 2Timothy Titus Philemon	Instructions on different aspects of ministry.
Transitional books from the Church Age to the Tribulation Period	Hebrews	Primary focus is Jewish. However, many spiritual principles are applicable to the church.

Apostle John

- The beloved disciple of Jesus Christ – John 13:23, John 19:26, and John 21:7, 20.
- The “Apostle of Love” by his extensive writings on love in the book of 1John.
- The writer of the book of Revelation.
- The only apostle to die a natural death.
- Uniquely used by God to proclaim His outreach and plan of salvation for mankind, His love, and His wrath.





The Gospel of John

- The gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke are collectively known as the synoptic gospels.
- John omits many of the accounts in the synoptic gospels and includes a considerable amount of material not found in them.
- John presents Jesus as the incarnate Word from heaven.





The Gospel of John

- John's purpose for his readers:
John 20:30 And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book: (31) But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.
- John the Baptist testified:
 - "This was he" – John 1:15
 - "This is he" – John 1:30
 - "This is the Son of God" – John 1:34
 - "Behold the Lamb of God" John 1:36
- *"But whom say ye that I am?" – Mark 8:27-29*



The Gospel of John

Uniqueness

- Major omissions
 - Temptation of Jesus
 - Sermon on the mount
 - Record of Jesus casting out demons
 - The “Lord’s prayer”
 - Jesus’ transfiguration
 - The Lord’s supper
- The phrase “*Verily, verily*”

- Major inclusions
 - John 2 – Wedding in Cana of Galilee
 - John 2 – The purging of the temple
 - John 3 – The meeting with Nicodemus

- If you are looking for a Savior, Jesus Christ is the Son of God from heaven.

Jo 1:15	"This was he"	Jo 6:51	"I am the living bread which came down from heaven"
Jo 1:30	"This is he"	Jo 8:12, Jo 9:5	"I am the light of the world"
Jo 1:34	"This is the Son of God"	Jo 10:11	"I am the good shepherd"
Jo 1:36	"Behold the Lamb of God"	Jo 11:25	"I am the resurrection, and the life"
Jo 6:35	"I am the bread of life"	Jo 14:6	"I am the way, the truth, and the life"

- If you know Jesus as Lord and Savior, be fruitful and be prepared for persecution.
 - *John 15:16 Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.*
 - *John 15:20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.*
