Last week we studied Jonah 2 and concluded that Jonah died in the belly of the great fish. God raised Jonah from the dead . We saw Jonah's soul saved from \_\_\_\_\_and his body saved from \_\_\_\_\_.

- The Sign of Jonas: Luke 11:27-32.

Jonah was a sign to the Ninevites.

Jesus is a sign to his generation: Men of Nineveh will rise up in judgment against the generation of Jesus' earthly ministry because the men of Nineveh repented when the WOG was preached to them. But when greater than Jonah rises from the dead to preach to them, will they receive it?

- Wicked generations seek a \_\_\_\_\_. This is contrasted with believing and keeping the Word of God.

1 Thess 2:13 vs Critical Spirit of the Pharisees seeking a sign (Matt 12:38).

Let's have a believing attitude. There are some who come with a \_\_\_\_\_of unbelief (Heb 3:12).

- Lu 16:19-31: If a man will not believe in God's Word he will not believe if a man rises from the dead and tells him to repent.
- John 11:43-46. Interestingly, a man named \_\_\_\_\_ did rise from the dead, and some who saw it believed. But some fulfilled Luke 16:31/Luke 11:3 The difference: Their view of the Word of God. (Matt 16:1-4, Mark 8:11-12, etc.)

**Seeking a Sign:**

"I will not believe it unless I decide it is true based on my expectations, understanding and approval."

**Small Group Discussion Questions:**

1. Do we really believe there is a hell? Another way to ask this: Do we understand what we have been saved from?
2. Do we understand that Salvation is of the Lord (Jonah 2:9)
3. Do we view the Word God in the proper estimation, or are we "looking for a sign"?
4. Do we have a burden for the lost that arises from our understanding of hell?
