






V.6: The Gourd and Jonah



A. The gourd vine was designed to bring comfort—to deliver him from his grief.


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

B. The gourd was a blessing.




V.7: The Worm and the Gourd




A. The worm was designed to smite the gourd so that it withered.

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


V.7: The Worm and the Gourd

- B. The gourd was temporary.




V. 8: The East Wind and Jonah:
