1. BACKGROUND:

Author - Paul, written by Paul himself (Gal 6:11)

Date written - AD 60

2. CHARACTERISTICS:

We find evidence Paul had a condition with his eyes (Gal 4:15). There are 2 phrases we don't find any where else in the bible: "Law of Christ" (Gal 6:2) and "Israel of God" (Gal 6:16).

3. KEY THEME:

Live your whole life by the faith in Jesus Christ that saved you.

4. ANCHOR VERSES:

"For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love." Gal. 5:5-6

5. BOOK OUTLINE:

- a. Chapters 1-2 -- Sanctity of the Gospel
- b. Chapters 3-4 -- Law vs Liberty
- c. Chapters 5-6 -- Walking in the Spirit

6. FAVORITE THING:

"As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all *men*, especially unto them who are of the household of faith." Gal. 6:10

Our church family, and especially Sunday worship, should be heaven on earth. And in many ways, we're doing it.

7. SUMMARY:

The Law brought us to Christ and was an active part of our salvation. But the new creature is spiritual and has no part in the Law. Live in the Spirit by faith. In doing so, you will crucify the flesh and fulfill the second great commandment which is to love thy neighbor as thyself (Matt 22:39; Mar 12:31).

 - _____ is clear → serpent on brass pole. Today this is the medical symbol.
