Review: Romans 6 Outline: 2 Sections that basically ask, "What then? And "Know ye not...." 1-14 and 15-23. Romans 6:1-14: Dead to Sin, alive unto God. We are to Know, Reckon, and Yield. Verses 1-2: Our "grace through faith" stance does not mean that we should continue to sin. We are dead to sin. Verses 3-14: Know, Reckon, Yield. **Know: Verses 6-10: Reckon: Verse 11:** Yield: Verses 12-14: We are \_\_\_\_\_\_to choose to whom we will . Jn 8:32. Our choices: Yield to \_\_\_\_\_ or to \_\_\_\_. (\_\_\_\_yielding is \_\_\_\_ an option). Yielding to sin results in unrighteousness. Yielding to God in righteousness. Yielding to sin indicates (Rom 6:1-3, 6-10) or (Rom 6:11) Not yielding to God reveals a gross misunderstanding of \_ (Like calling him Lord and not following his instructions). (Job 9:32), (Ps 24), (Lu 6:46-49), (Ps 34:8). Vs 14: Conclusion: Sin does not have dominion over us. We are not under the law (which defines sin), but under grace. This brings us back full circle to our position in grace. **Gal 5:13.**
