

Either what you are saying about man's universal guilt is untrue, or what God has been saying all along about the Jews being special is untrue. BTW, if right is wrong, then I am not accountable to it.



Heart Attitude behind Questions 2 &3: Wrong is Right:



Heart Attitude behind Questions 2 &3: Wrong is Right: If our unbelief or unrighteous display God's goodness by contrast, then I am justified in unbelief or unrighteousness. If wrong is right, I am justified in my sin.

Answer: No, all men are <u>liars</u> anyway—(this adds to the argument at hand) (cross ref is Ps 51:4)





Psa 51:1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy ovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

10.51:2 Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin.

sa 51:3 For I acknowledge my transgression and my sin is ever before me.

Psa 51:4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned and done this evil in thy sight: that thou test be justified when thou speakest, and clear when thou judgest.

Question 4: This is a rhetorical question: (V.7) If what you are saying is true, and I am lying, then why are you judging me for it? (8) Why not just follow you own counsel and join in with those who say, "Let us do evil, that good may come."
