


Our <u>position</u> of being "In Christ" comes <u>before</u> our <u>practice</u> of "Walking in the Spirit."


Review:




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
Walking after the flesh is to have <u>confidence</u> in the flesh. Walking after the Spirit is to have <u>confidence</u> in the Spirit.













- Gal 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.
- Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Gal 2:21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.

Romans 8:10 with Gal 2:19-21

My position of being dead is followed by the practice of mortifying and putting off (Col 3:5-8).

So, victory comes then, not through self, but through surrender.

Romans 8:10 with Gal 2:19-21

Php 3:3 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.

Php 3:4 Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more:

Romans 8:3-4 with Php 3:3-11

It is not <u>enough</u> that we have confidence in God (in the Spirit). We must forsake confidence in <u>self.</u>

Romans 8:3-4 with Php 3:3-11

To be carnally minded is man's natural selfish state. "What I want". This leads to envying, strife, etc. It does not lead to satisfaction. When we want "What we want" we are carnally minded as above. We must surrender that in order to walk after the Spirit. What I want is the problem, not the solution.

- 1Co 3:1 And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ.
- 1Co 3:2 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able.
- 1Co 3:3 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

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
