




Our position of being “In Christ” comes before our practice of

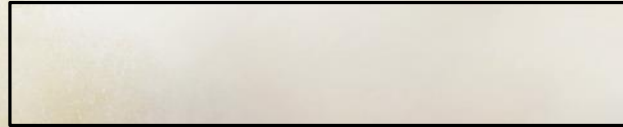
Walking after the flesh is to have confidence in the flesh.

Life and Peace,

- Gal 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.
- Gal 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Gal 2:21 I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness *come* by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.



My position of being dead is followed by the practice of mortifying and putting off (Col 3:5-8).

So, victory comes then, not through self, but through surrender.




Rom 8:6 with 1 Co 3:1-3

1Co 3:1 And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, *even* as unto babes in Christ.

1Co 3:2 I have fed you with milk, and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able *to bear it*, neither yet now are ye able.

1Co 3:3 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas *there is* among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?
