The difference between training and discipline

Training is proactive, discipline is Responsive.

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

Pro 22:6

What is the way he should go? Answer.... It's the same as the way we should go.

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man.

Ecc 12:13

We need to make sure that we set a path for our kids that makes living God's way easier.

Ecclesiastes 12:13 can be summed up with respect and obey. This verse hits both attitude and behavior.

- Heb 12:5 And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him:
- Heb 12:6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.
- Heb 12:7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?
 - Heb 12:8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons.
- Heb 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live?
- Heb 12:10 For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of his holiness.
 - Heb 12:11 Now no chastening for the present seemeth to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yieldeth the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby.
- Heb 12:12 Wherefore lift up the hands which hang down, and the feeble knees; Heb 12:13 And make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed.

The training and education of children needs to include the training and care of the body, navigating life, and curbing passions. It needs to result in an education in mind, morals, and moderation.

KEY 1: Start early and be consistent.

Training is the difference between baby proofing your house and house proofing your baby.

. **KEY 2:** to train correctly you need to free up your brain and free up your time.

top 5 ways to teach respect.

- 1)Teach them to say "Yes, mom" and "Yes Dad" after every instruction you give and to do the same with their other authorities.
 - 2) Have your children address all adults with a title. Mr. smith, Miss Tammy.
- 3)Demonstrate respect by how you treat and speak to your authorities and the other authorities in your kid's lives
- 4)show your children respect. Say please and thank you to them. If they are the most important people in the world to you than your tone, words, and body language should reflect that.
- 5)be a consistent authority. Always win the battles you pick with your kids. Ioo% of them.

Your kid's life may very well depend on your consistency with obedience training.

For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth.

Heb 12:6

- Pro 13:24 He that spareth his rod hateth his son: but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.
- **Pro 23:13** Withhold not correction from the child: for *if* thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die.
- Pro 23:14 Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell.
- Pro 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.
 - **Pro 10:13** ... but a rod *is* for the back of him that is void of understanding.
- Pro 22:15 Foolishness *is* bound in the heart of a child; *but* the rod of correction shall drive it far from him.
 - Psa 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

God intends us to direct our kids to the cross with their sin not teach them to deal with it with their flesh.

Psa 89:30 If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments;

Psa 89:31 If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments;

Psa 89:32 Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes.

Psa 89:33 Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail.

Your relationship with your kids is crucial and your love must be unconditional.

Eph 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

Eph 6:2 Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;)

Eph 6:3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

Col 3:20 Children, obey *your* parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

Children should obey us how we should obey God.

Because sentence against an evil work is not executed speedily, therefore the heart of the sons of men is fully set in them to do evil.



- 1)Done in private.
- 2)Done after the child knows what they are getting disciplined for.
- 3)With a calm and sober parent and a child as sober as possible.
- 4)One swat for every year of age.
- 5) followed by forgiveness being asked and given and restitution and hugs to wrap things
 - 6) pray together.
