- 3 “Faithful Sayings” by Paul, all in the pastoral epistles - 1 Tim 4:9; 2 Tim 2:11; Titus 3:8

II. Our Common _____.

Christ Jesus came into the world to save _____;

Because God so loved the whole world, something HAD to happen in order that we could be saved from our sin and set as ONE with the Saviour.

A Salvation / Message for ALL: Mankind was lost, in route to hell. But God has spanned the barrier of sin to make a way of salvation for us.

- This good news is worthy of **all acceptance** because it is a message from God to **ALL mankind!**
- This good news is worthy of **all acceptance**, because **He/Jesus Christ is worthy.** Rev 4:11
- This Good News is worthy of all acceptance, because you need a Saviour!
All mankind is to benefit from the message. **ALL have sinned...** Rom 3:22-24; 1 Cor 15:1-4

...but, **ALL can be Saved!**

Nothing is more important to God than his desire to have an eternal relationship with you.

III. An Exceptional _____! Vs 15-16

Review: Acts 9:1-22

- Saul was the ultimate sinner. He was a killer of God's children (Ex: Act 7, Stephen. He was a persecutor of Christ Himself! (Vs 5) *1 Tim 1:13; 1 Cor 15:9-10*
- In submitting his life to Christ, **everything** changed!
Job 42:5-6; Isa 55:7-9

Now Saul / Paul became a new creature in Christ! *2 Cor 5:17*

The change is so dramatic that his very desires change. (Acts 9:18-22)

What God did for the worst sinner (The Apostle Paul) – it's a pattern and a proof that He can do the same for you! Rom 5:6-10

God has made a way of Salvation for All! He in His power and might – broke down the wall of sin that separates mankind from Him, and made a way of salvation.

You can have a relationship with God. You can have eternal life. Jesus must be resurrected in your heart! *2 Pet 3:9*
