The Office of Deacon: Leaders in Ministry Service. 1 Tim 3:8-13

We will be taking Deacon nominations thru the week of July 12th.

Peter said that our elders are to be ENSAMPLES! 1 Peter 5:3; 1 Tim 4:12

You cannot DO what God wants you to do, until you ARE the kind of person God wants you to be.

You are disqualified for ministry if you do match the description listed in this passage.

You will never reach perfection, but you want to be "un-rebuke-able!"

I. What is a Deacon?

The word for "deacon" appears 30 times in 28 verses...in all its renderings.

Ex: John 12:26; 1 Cor 3:5; Matt 20:25-27

Deacon: diakonos "a servant"

This role applies to both male and female: Rom 16:1

That's the exact same word that is translated as deacon. = Paul called her a <u>Deaconess!</u>

SEE: Our leadership is not comprised of "lords" over God's people, but "servants" to God's People.

Ministry principle # 6 Our Leaders Are Servant Leaders.

#5 reads Our Members Engage in Ministry Service

- II. What spiritual qualifications are required in a deacon?
- **#1. Grave.** This is the same as the first qualification for the deacon's wife.

Grave = venerable, i.e. honorable:--grave, honest. Phil 4:8-9

Why? The reason for the office of Deacon – Ex: Acts 6:1-3

This is the reason that the qualifications overlap so much. The deacon is chosen out of those who are "deac-ing", they are the extension, or right arm of the Pastor.

Deacons serve in the pastor's place.

Notice vs 3: they are appointed "over this business." They are administrators.

#2. 3:8 "not Double-Tongued" Ps 5:9; 52:2-3; 12:2; James 3:10; 1:8

You cannot have 2 tongues! Ex: one for Sunday and one for the rest of the week! We need straight talkers in the office of deacon.

- **#3. 3:8 not given to much wine,** (*This was the 8th qualification of a Pastor*) Prov 20:1 Our thinking must be influenced by the Holy Spirit not chemicals! Eph 5:17-19
- #4. 3:8 not greedy of filthy lucre; 1 Tim 6:10; Heb 13:5

Filthy lucre = money gotten by improper methods. 1 Sam 8:1-3 We don't need men who are "respecters of persons" – God's not! We need to minister to rich and the poor, the likable and dislikable, the good, bad, and the ugly!
