Jerusalem – Acts 2:41, 4:32


Antioch – Acts 11:26-30, 13:1-3





WILES OF THE DEVIL


We are told to stand against the wiles of the devil. The English word, "wiles" comes up twice in your Bibles. Once in Ephesians 6:11 and also in Numbers 25:18.



THE DEVIL'S GOAL

The enemy's attacks are meant to DISPLACE you and DERAIL you so that you will DEPART from your holy mission that was given by God.

In succumbing to his trickery you end up *leaving*your holy calling for a poor substitute.



THE STORY OF BALAK AND BALAAM

Numbers 22-24 provides context to this passage.
Balak has asked Balaam to curse the children of Israel.
Balaam is not allowed to do this by God, but instead privily instructs Balak on how Israel can be undone.
