Why we aren't Calvinists.

Our goal is to be Bible believers.

Our only options are?

- OCalvinism vs. Armenianism?
- OGod's sovereignty vs. Man's free will?
- The eternal security of the believer vs. a salvation you can lose?

We want to hold a biblical position instead of relying on a man's view of the Bible doctrine.

KEY: A plain and <u>literal</u> view of the Text is best.

We don't want to be guilty of having to force our theology onto the plain words of Scripture in order to change their clear meaning.

We reject Calvin's doctrine

- Olt can be summed up in the acronym <u>TULIP.</u>
- OTULIP: Beautiful flower bad theology.



- O <u>Total</u> depravity of man. Most would agree! Ro 3:10-12, Jer 17:9
- Calvinists mean "total depravity" to be "utter inability."
- False teaching: God has to regenerate you (save you) <u>BEFORE</u> you can believe.
- O What the Bible says...

Is 53:6, Ac 17:30, Ro 10:16-17, 1 Pe 1:23



- Unconditional Election
- OThe Calvinist says, "To reject (Calvinistic) election is to reject salvation by grace and promote salvation by works.
- O What the Bible says...

Ep 2:8-9, Jos 24:15, 1 Ki 18:21, etc...

OLimited Atonement

OThe Calvinist says that Christ didn't die for everyone - just the elect only.

OWhat the Bible says...

Jo 3:16, 1 Jo 2:1-2, 5:19, 1 Ti 2:4-6, He 2:9, etc...

OH. A. Ironside – "It has been well said that the "Whosoever wills are the elect, and the whosoever won'ts are the non-elect"

- Olrresistible Grace
- Calvinists deny the will of man.
 God is the cause of EVERYTHING.
- OWait. God's GRACE is **forced** on man?
- OWhat the Bible says...

Ep 2:8-9



- OPerseverance of the saints
- Olt is true "once saved always saved!"
- On But the Calvinist's assurance that he is one of God's elect is based upon his <u>performance!</u>
- OWhat the Bible says...
 - Jo 3:15-16, 5:24, 1 Jo 5:11-13

The problem.

- The Gospel isn't supposed to be this complicated!
- OLittle children should be able to understand it! 2 Tim 3:15
- OWhy are we so confused?

The history and result of a Calvinistic (Augustinian) doctrinal viewpoint.

- OAugustine's theology forms the basis for Calvinism.
- Calvinistic doctrine is Reformed.
 - Obabies are baptized for salvation.
 - OAllegorical interpretation.
 - Othose rejecting Calvinistic doctrine were persecuted.

- Calvin believed it was ok to persecute or kill "heretics..."
 ...so he did.
- OKey: what you believe effects how you live!
- OAt least 60 were burned at the stake under Calvin.
- OHundreds were imprisoned, tortured and persecuted under him.

- OGod is love. Ps 86:15, 145:8-9, 1 Cor 13:4-8
- OGod is not willing that any perish! 2 Pe 3:9, 1 Ti 2:1-4, Rom 9:1-3

The Gospel is simple.

- God chose us, and predestined us to all spiritual blessings before the foundation of all creation. Why?
- OBecause He saw us respond to His invitation to choose Christ, His sacrifice, His Gospel.
- We are "elect" according to the foreknowledge of God.
- •To foreknow is not the same thing as to foreordain!
